# Sam Falcetti Workshop on Enhancing the Left Hand

My thanks to Jim Avedisian on getting Sam to come to our June meeting with such a great workshop.....Sam, as personable and entertaining as always, really wowed the audience with his playing style and left hand techniques....I've attached some comments that I received....

I hope you enjoyed Sam Falcetti's presentation. There are a few of the left hand things I myself will try. It's nice to think about the left hand sometimes. When you figure out that each counter bass is a third from the root ( $\mathcal{C}$  counterbass is  $\mathcal{E}$ ) and that each 2 buttons represents a whole step ( $\mathcal{C}$  D  $\mathcal{E}$ ,  $\mathcal{G}$  A  $\mathcal{B}$ , etc.) and that each button in sequence is a fifth ( $\mathcal{C}$  G D , etc.) it makes it easier to understand how to do some really neat bass things. Knowing the counter basses makes doing walking bass runs very easy. And by using counter basses, you don't have to stretch your fingers all over the place.....Jim Avedisian.

I concur about the meeting on Sunday. I've always wanted to learn how to walk the bases, I've tried it before on my own and Sam's ideas will help master the trick....Lewis Howes
